



Beginning with the 2021/2022 academic year, eligibility for Low-Income and Overflow Tax Credit Scholarships expanded to include students who were homeschooled before enrolling directly in a qualified private school.

For students finishing the current school year in homeschool, they will be eligible for Low-Income and Overflow Scholarships for the upcoming academic year. If the transition occurs within the same academic year, as long as the transition is from homeschooling directly to the private school, they are also eligible.

A Homeschool Verification Form must be completed by the parent and submitted with the Academic Opportunity of Arizona Scholarship Application along with one of the following documents:

- Affidavit of Intent to Homeschool filed with your County School Superintendent
- Homeschool withdrawal form from your County School Superintendent
- Proof of purchase of homeschool curriculum

The requirement is to verify that the student was homeschooled immediately prior to enrolling in a private school.
